Daniel Friedman is a Distinguished Professor Emeritus at the University of California, Santa Cruz, Professor of Economics at University of Essex , and Founder of the LEEPS Lab. Dan has over 100 academic publications, largely studying financial markets and strategic behavior, often in the laboratory and often in continuous time. Additionally, Dan has co-authored fifteen NSF grants and was a previous President of the Economic Science Association.

Dan has published pioneering work particularly in the experimental markets literature, spanning nearly 50 years. Since his dissertation's contributions on disequilibrium dynamics in pure exchange economies, Dan has provided both experimental and theoretical advancements to the partial and general equilibrium literatures. He has examined many market formats, with the largest emphasis being placed on the continuous double auction and the call market. More recent works have targeted either concerns in high frequency trade financial markets, or preferences and induction advancements in general equilibrium CDA markets.
