Peter Bossaerts is the William D. Hacker Professor of Economics and Management and Professor of Finance at the California Institute of Technology. Peter's research and publications encompass many areas of theoretical, empirical and experimental finance. His work employs tools from various fields, such as decision theory, general equilibrium theory, game theory, cognitive psychology, and decision neuroscience. Peter has published in major journals in finance, economics, econometrics, science and neuroscience. He has taught undergraduate, MBA, PhD and executive classes at various places across the world. He is Fellow of the Econometric Society and of the Society for the Advancement of Economic Theory. He was president of The Society for Neuroeconomics, and is or has been on the board of many academic journals, including the *Review of Finance*, the *Review of Financial Studies*, and *Mathematical Finance*.
